

## Restrictions on Narcotics

According to the Narcotics Act B.E. 2522 (1972) and amended by the Narcotics Act B.E 2562(2019)

Classification	Restrictions	Exemption
Category 1	Import/export/possession strictly prohibited without permission from the MOPH	Import/export/possession for the benefit of government agencies with permission from the Minister of Public Health
Category 2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Import/export/possession strictly prohibited without permission from the MOPH</li> <li>• Permission granted for medical purposes <i>Medication brought into Thailand by travelers for personal use:</i></li> <li>• Limited quantities are allowed for personal use (30 days of prescribed usage)</li> <li>• A medical treatment letter/prescription from the prescribing physician is required</li> <li>• A completed application for the applicable permit from the Thai FDA is required</li> </ul>	
Category 3	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Import/export/possession strictly prohibited without permission from the MOPH</li> <li>• Permission granted for medical purposes</li> </ul>	
Category 4 (chemicals used for producing category 1 and 2 narcotics)	Import/export/possession strictly prohibited without permission from the MOPH	With permission from the Minister of Public Health in accordance with approval from the Narcotics Committee
Category 5	<p>Import/export/possession strictly prohibited without permission from the MOPH</p> <p><b>*Note*</b> Currently the importation/exportation of medicinal products that made from Cannabis or Hemp are prohibited. The regulations for traveler import/export those medications are not implemented yet.</p>	With permission from the Minister of Public Health in accordance with approval from the Narcotics Committee
