

Restrictions on psychotropic substances
According to the Psychotropic Substances Act B.E. 2559 (2016)

| Classification | Restrictions | Exemption |

| Category 1 | Import/export/possession strictly prohibited without permission from the MOPH | Permission granted for the Ministry of Public Health or authorized official from the Ministry of Public Health |
| Category 2 | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Import/export/possession strictly prohibited without permission from the MOPH • Permission granted for Medical purposes | Travelers may carry for personal use: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Limited quantities are allowed for personal use (30 days of prescribed usage) • A medical treatment letter/ prescription from the prescribing physician is required |
| Category 3-4 | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Import/export/possession strictly prohibited without permission from the MOPH • Permission granted for Medical purposes | Same as category 2 Travelers may carry for personal use: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Limited quantities are allowed for personal use (30 days of prescribed usage) • A medical treatment letter/ prescription from the prescribing physician is required |
